Four internal, actively-controlled Seakeeper M7000 Gyros virtually eliminate boat rock and roll for superior onboard comfort. Delivering a powerful righting force, they provide unmatched stability while at anchor, zero and low speeds or underway.

"During sea trials, the gyros proved to be noticeably effective in multiple conditions," said Özden. "Underway, the ride is smoother with

less roll. When you turn them off, you immediately notice the difference. They're so quiet. You can't even tell they're running unless you look at the control panel."
