## SEAKEEPER TO OFFER FREE ENTRY TO BIG ROCK AND PIRATES COVE

The good news is the offshore fishing tournament season is ready to rock and roll. The great news is the boats participating don't have to anymore. With the purchase of a Seakeeper Gyro Stabilizer, Seakeeper will pay the entry fee for either one of two of the largest big game fishing competitions in the country, the Big Rock Blue Marlin Tournament and Pirate's Cove Billfish Tournament. As an added bonus, Seakeeper will provide the owner a Visa gift card good for fuel, tackle or libations.

Seakeeper is changing boating and the way people fish forever. Anglers can now land more fish with more time on the water—all in total comfort. The 53rd Big Rock Blue Marlin Tournament is being held June 10-18 in Morehead City, North Carolina. When an angler purchases a Seakeeper Gyro before June 1, 2011, Seakeeper will pay for the \$4,000 Level I, CSI Gamefish Level V and Gamefish Level V.I entry fees, and hand over a \$3,000 Visa gift card for a total value of \$7,000. largest nonprofit event of its kind on the East Coast, over the years donating \$2 million to charity. Last year 156 boats competed for their share of the \$1.6 million purse, with the winner bringing in a 528.30 lb. blue marlin.

For the 28th annual Pirate's Cove Billfish Tournament, August 15-19 in Wanchese, North Carolina, Seakeeper will pay the C1 base entry fee with the purchase of a gyro by August 1, 2010. This is a \$4,850 value, plus the \$3,000 Visa gift card for a total of \$7,850. Top prize money is a tempting \$850,000 based on 120 entries.

At both tournaments, Seakeeper will host free demonstrations on its 43' Viking Sportfish, which experiences up to 80% roll reduction from a Seakeeper M7000A gyro. In addition to Viking, other major sportfish brands that have Seakeeper units installed include Maritimo, Silverton, Mikelson, Riviera, Garlington, F&S and Richie Howell, with more sportfishing brands underway.

Whether fishing in rough waters at zero speed, trolling at low speed or running wide open to a hot spot, the advanced Seakeeper Gyro virtually eliminates boat roll for unmatched comfort, safety and fish-fighting effectiveness—all without drag-producing and damage-prone external fins or appendages.
